On April 7, 2022, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) issued a CONSENT ORDER (CONSENT ORDER) against Roxboro Savings Bank, SSB, Roxboro, North Carolina (Bank), pursuant to section 8(b) of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act, 12 U.S.C. § 1818(b). The North Carolina Office of Commissioner of Banks (NCOCB) joined in the issuance of the CONSENT ORDER pursuant to North Carolina General Statute § 54C-76. The NCOCB terminated its participation in the CONSENT ORDER on March 29, 2023.

The FDIC hereby issues this ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER, terminating all provisions of the CONSENT ORDER, effective as of December 13, 2023.
